AGREED ORDER OF REFERENCE

By agreement of the parties and pursuant to M.R.Civ. P. 53(b)(1) and 19-A M.R.S.A. § 252,
it is HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. This matter is referred to Matthew F. Dyer, Esq. of Augusta, who shall serve as referee for adjudication of the complaint (and counterclaim) in this divorce action.
2. The referee shall have the power to receive and report evidence, to fix the time and place for hearings and to make a record of the evidence taken.
3. If the parties so request, the referee shall prepare a report upon the matters decided and shall make findings of fact and conclusions of law.
4. Each party shall retain the right of appeal on issues of law; the referees findings and facts shall be final if supported by competent evidence.
5. The referee shall file his report with the Clerk of the Court together with the original exhibits and a transcript if one is requested and paid for by either party.
